**TOURNAMENT A: "MASTER" Restricted to players with ELO (FSI and/or FIDE) higher than 1799.**

The tournament is rated by FIDE and FSI – Swiss system pairing.

Tie break rules: 1) Integral Buchholz, 2) Median Buchholz (Hi-Lo), 3) Average Rating of Opponents (ARO).

9 rounds - Rate of play: 90 minutes for 40 moves then 30 minutes, 30 seconds bonus per move as from the beginning.

**TOURNAMENT B: Libero and Zora Polojaz 7th Trophy**

Restricted to players with ELO (FSI and/or FIDE) lower than 2100.

Rated by FIDE & FSI - Swiss system pairing.

Tie break rules: 1) Integral Buchholz, 2) Median Buchholz (Hi-Lo), 3) Average Rating of Opponents (ARO).

9 rounds. Rate of play: 90 minutes + 30 seconds bonus per move as from the beginning.

### MARINO BONIFACIO PLATE (prize for the brightest game)

A **PLATE**, will be assigned to the author of the most brilliant game of the first 8 rounds. The choice will be limited to games proposed to the Organizing Committee by the players themselves. Judge will be designed by a dedicated committee. No appeal is admitted.

### RULES

- Both Italian and foreign players can participate. Italian participants (as well as those who are resident in Italy) must have their FSI card valid for the current year. FSI card can be obtained on registering. Foreigner participants have to supply a document, issued by their Chess Federation, certifying their title and ELO rating. Foreign players, without FIDE Elo, who are unable to certify their national rating, will not participate to rating bands prizes.
- Tournament provides for 9 rounds and Swiss system pairing.
- The tournaments will take place at the Palazzo Vivante, Largo Papa Giovanni XXIII, 7 Trieste (15 minutes from the rail station and from the parking site named "Silos" or 5 minutes from the rail station by bus nr. 30). Smoking, as well as the use of mobile phones and any sort of electronic devices, is strictly forbidden in the premises of the Festival.
- Registration implies the acceptance of all Festival rules. The organizers are authorized to introduce any alterations they may consider necessary for the best performance of the event. Participants accept that information relevant to the tournaments, either personal data or the results of the games or the games themselves, can be processed and circulated according to the Act 675/96 on the right to privacy.
- What is not provided for in the present rules will be managed according to the rules emanated by FIDE, FSI and CONI (Italian Olympic Committee). Players who are not at their desk within 30 minutes from the time provided for by this announcement, will loose the game.
- Arbiter's decisions are final
- The organizers of the International Trieste Chess Festival will not be liable for any damage caused to persons or things before, during and after the Festival.
- In order to get expenses refunded, winners must supply their personal fiscal code and, if under 18, written authorization by their parents.
